Hempstead is the most populous village in Nassau County. Residents value its cultural richness, location, and sense of community. Community-based organizations offer resources and support.



Most residents in Hempstead are Latine or Black. More than one-third of residents were born outside the United States. Nearly one-half of residents speak a language other than English at home, with Spanish being the most common. Educational attainment is lower in Hempstead than Nassau County.


Home Language

% individuals aged 5+ years by language spoken at home




60% of Spanishspeakers in Hempstead speak English less than very well

Income

Hempstead is a working-class neighborhood. Wages earned by Hempstead workers are lower than wages of workers in Nassau County. A higher percent of Hempstead residents live in households with incomes below the poverty level than residents in Nassau County.


Average Earnings for Workers

Median earnings for workers aged 16+ years




Home Ownership

% housing units renter-occupied




Birth Place

% individuals born outside United States




Educational Attainment

% individuals aged 25+ years by education




Poverty

Housing and Vehicle Access

More than one-half of housing units in Hempstead are renter-occupied.

Hempstead is a public transportation hub. Nearly one-quarter of households in Hempstead do not have access to a vehicle, more than three times the rate as Nassau County.


Data at a Glance

Health Insurance

A higher percent of Hempstead residents lack health insurance than residents in Nassau County. This is largely due to the difference in health insurance rates for adults 19 to 64 years old, including many employed adults, who do not have health insurance. Hempstead has a higher percent of residents with public health insurance than residents in Nassau County.


No Health Insurance

Public Health Insurance


% individuals with public health insurance

Rates of diabetes, obesity, and high blood pressure are higher among adults living in Hempstead than Nassau County.




Age-adjusted rate per 10,000 adults
