Quality Ranking Definitions:

O:E Mortality – The ratio of observed to expected (O:E) mortalities using patient-level performance data from the Vizient Clinical Data Base.

O:E Length of Stay – The ratio of observed to expected (O:E) length of stay using patient-level performance data from the Vizient Clinical Data Base.

Readmissions – The percentage of cases eligible for readmission within 30 days of discharge from the index admission using patient-level performance data from the Vizient Clinical Data Base.

CMS Star Rating – Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) assigns a rating of 1 to 5-stars based on how individual hospitals perform compared to all hospitals across the country for the following 7 groups of quality measures: mortality, safety of care, readmissions, patient experience, effectiveness of care, timeliness of care, and efficient use of medical imaging. Leapfrog Safety Grade – The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade uses up to 27 national performance measures from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), the Leapfrog Hospital Survey and information from other supplemental data sources. Taken together, those performance measures produce a single letter grade representing a hospital's overall performance in keeping patients safe from preventable harm and medical errors. The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade methodology has been peer reviewed and published in the Journal of Patient Safety (Source: <https://www.hospitalsafetygrade.org/>).

Vizient Ambulatory Care Quality & Accountability – The Vizient Ambulatory Care Quality and Accountability Ranking measures the quality of outpatient care in five domains: access to care, continuum of care, quality, efficiency, and equity (Source: <https://www.vizientinc.com>).

Vizient Academic Medical Center Quality & Accountability – The Vizient Bernard A. Birnbaum, MD, Quality Leadership Award is given annually to comprehensive academic medical centers that demonstrate superior performance, as measured by the Vizient Quality and Accountability Ranking program of patient care in six domains: mortality, efficiency, effectiveness, patient centeredness, safety, and equity (Source: <https://www.vizientinc.com>).

U.S. News Best Hospitals – Just 20 hospitals out of nearly 5,000 evaluated for the 2022-23 U.S. News Best Hospitals rankings and ratings made the Honor Roll. Hospitals were awarded Honor Roll points if they ranked in one or more of the 15 specialties that U.S. News evaluates – more points for higher rankings – and if they were rated "high performing" in one or more of the twenty procedures and conditions.
